UPDATE: FAIRVIEW PARK MASTER PLAN DRAFT

Dear Fairview Park Master Plan email subscribers,

Thank you for your interest and participation in the City of Costa Mesa's Fairview Park Master Plan Update.

As you know, the City of Costa Mesa has been working with the consulting firm MIG for a number of years preparing and updating the Fairview Park Master Plan. The Master Plan was originally adopted in 1998 and was last revised in 2008. The Master Plan provides a framework to guide the improvement, restoration, public use, and management of Fairview Park's unique assets and open space recreational amenities within existing environmental and cultural constraints. The Master Plan also serves as a management tool for sustainable park maintenance protocols and educational opportunities to the community.

Due to the size of the document, the age of the old Master Plan, and the volume of graphic and text material, this review and editing process entails extensive coordination between staff and the consultant team to produce a publish-ready draft. The consultant team is currently in the process of addressing final revisions and we anticipate releasing the Master Plan draft the week of September 29, 2025. Once released, the Master Plan Draft will be available for public review for a minimum of 30 days.

We know that the community is eager to begin reviewing the Fairview Park Master Plan Draft documents and we appreciate your patience as we work with the consultant team to finalize the document. The City has tentatively scheduled the Master Plan Draft to be discussed at the November 18, 2025 City Council meeting.

The TRUST Test and FAA Registration

TRUST is <u>The Recreational UAS Safety Test</u>. It provides education and testing for recreational flyers on important safety and regulatory information. If you fly your drone recreationally under the <u>Exception for Recreational Flyers</u> you must pass the test before you fly. To take the test, go to http://trust.modelaircraft.org. This is the AMA Site. Take the test (Don't worry, it is fail proof) then obtain your "Completion Certificate."

All recreational flyers must pass this aeronautical knowledge and safety test and provide proof of test passage (the TRUST completion certificate) to the FAA or law enforcement upon request.

Go to http://faadronezone.faa.gov and create an account for your FAA Registration. Apply for "I fly under The Exception For Recreational Flyers". They will issue you an FAA registration number that must be affixed to the outside of all of your radio control model aircraft. The charge is \$3 for three years, for all of your R/C aircraft.

All recreational flyers must pass this aeronautical knowledge and safety test and provide proof of test passage (the TRUST completion certificate) to the FAA or law enforcement upon request.

Go to http://faadronezone.faa.gov and create an account for your FAA Registration. Apply for "I fly under The Exception For Recreational Flyers". They will issue you an FAA registration number that must be affixed to the outside of all of your radio control model aircraft. The charge is \$3 for three years, for all of your R/C aircraft.
