

Flying Classification

Since the March contest we have been using a new pilot classification system, as outlined in the March newsletter. Ken Nelson is the first sportsman to advance to the expert class. Ken had 3 contests in a row with a normalized score of 750 or better. Ken's average normalized score for his 3 contests is 885 pt.

Tasks: AMA Task IIA- Precision Duration. Three flights to make 21 minutes with no flight beyond 9 minutes. Flight scored at 1 point per second. Penalty points of 1 point per second in excess of 9 and 21 minutes.

Bonus Points: Landing at an odd minute (3,5,7,9) earns 105 pts and 30 seconds away from an odd minute earns 0 pts.

Landing Points: Points will be awarded at 5% and 10% of the flight score. The landing area has two parallel lines 5 feet apart and 25 feet long.
