JUNE CONTEST

On June 7th H.S.S. will hold a class 'B' Electric sailplane contest for club members at Estancia High School starting at 9:00 A.M. Awards for the top three. Pilot's meeting at 8:45 A.M. Tasks to be best 3 flights of 4 or 5 rounds of 8 Minute duration after engine run. (Max. engine run to be approx. 3 to 4 minutes based upon contestants wishes at pilot's meeting) A landing runway will be used at 10-25-40-25-10 points. Flight score at 2 points per second up to 8 minutes with one minute to land. Penalty points for flying over 9 minutes.

FIRST FLIGHTS: at 9:00 A.M. -- called flight order
normal (SC)² type non-standard 6 volt winches (1 or 2 12 volt
winches) line length approx. 600 feet

LANDING AREA: standard 25 foot radius circle on grass between sailplane-eating
baseball backstops.

TASKS: 3 rounds of precision duration to total 17 minutes.
No flight under 2 minutes or over 8 minutes.
2700 points for flights and 300 points for landings.
Lose 3 points per second for each second under or over an exact minute.
Penalty points for flying over 8:30 in one flight or over 17 minutes
total. Lose 180 points per minute for each minute under 17.

NOTE: There will be a qualifying landing area.
