Be a Concerned Enthusiast – Support the AMA

As discussed in the April 2012 issue of Model Aviation (the AMA publication sent to all AMA members), the federal government has passed the FAA Modernization and Reform Act of 2012, which includes Sec. 336 Special Rule For Model Aircraft. This law prevents the FAA from passing any rule that controls model aircraft being flown under the AMA safety code. The details appear on pages 14 and 15 of the April 2012 issue of Model Aviation. This Act resulted in part by the 90,000+ letters written by AMA members to their representatives.

The AMA will shortly be facing a new FAA regulation called the "small Unmanned Aircraft Systems" (sUAS) rule. In the next several months the FAA will post the preliminary regulation for public review. At this time the AMA will initiate a concerned citizens organization made up of AMA members to express their opinions of the preliminary regulation. To do this rapidly, the AMA will again contact all members by E-mail with instructions on comments and congressional contacts, which means the AMA needs everyone's current E-mail address. If you are not presently receiving occasional E-mail from the AMA, please go to www.modelaircraft.org and update your personal information. It is important for all of us to actively support the AMA especially in this endeavor.

Minutes From City of Costa Mesa Meetings, 27 Dec 2012

Three meetings were held on 27 Dec 2012. Two were with City of Costa Mesa management staff.

The first meeting was with Robert Staples, Manager of Fairview Park, from 10:30 until 12. The primary discussion was obtaining a 5 year use agreement. The second meeting was with Robert Knapp, Recreation Manager at Public Services Department, from 12 to 1:30. A brief luncheon meeting was held by HSS members. HSS attendees included Henry Smith III, John Rittenhouse, John Anderson, and Fred Hesse.

Principal notes from meeting with Robert Staples:

- Robert discussed the new members of the Parks Commission and City Council.
- Robert fully supports a 5 year agreement. He will send us a draft copy of the presentation he is preparing for the Parks and Recreation Commission (Copy received 28 Dec 2012).
- The Parks and Recreation Commission meeting will be Wednesday 23 Jan 2013, at 6 PM in the main committee room at Costa Mesa city hall. The commission will make their determination of the use agreement at that time.
- This proposed use agreement will be placed before the City Council on Tuesday 19 Feb 2013, at 6 PM also in the main committee room at the city hall.
- HSS members are invited to both meetings, and will be allowed to make short statements to the Commissioners and City Council members.

The following are ancillary notes from the meeting with Robert Staples:

- The proposed parking lot project is not part of the present park development plan.
- Robert discussed a number of funded improvements scheduled for Fairview Park. A Tot Lot will be added, and repairs to the bluff area are planned. The asphalt foot path will be replaced by a concrete

path. HSS suggested that the path be relocated 10 to 15 feet South of the existing path, and that dirt trails leading to the runway be obliterated. A request was made to include a water pipe adjacent to the path, although this is not part of the base line project.

- A 10 car parking lot will be added at the end of Pacific Avenue. This is adjacent to the apartment houses near the south west bluff.
- There have been no recent complaints about model aircraft noise.
- The HSS storage container will remain where it is.
- At this time there will be no change to the weight limit of aircraft. It is still 10 pounds maximum.
- It would be appreciated if HSS would conduct another park clean-up day.
- The ponds in the north area of park development will soon be filled with water. There is a remote possibility of flying float planes off of the pond surfaces.
- The train club wishes to expand their layout, and is requesting a 50 year use permit. They anticipate building a community center as part of their track development if this is approved.
- SPECIAL NOTE: The city code was changed in February 2012. It is now illegal to smoke in any public park. The fine is \$280.

Robert Knapp invited the HSS representatives for a discussion of his views on what HSS might contribute towards coming Costa Mesa activities, and public service. Robert appears to be very enthusiastic about HSS, and could be a major contact for community service activities. The following comments were made:

- Robert Knapp wishes to include a one page description of HSS for his newly expanded quarterly
 magazine aimed at recreational activities. This should include photos of our field, description of the
 planes we fly, and special emphasis on the free flying lessons we offer. Our material is needed in the
 next month. This will be a good opportunity to advertise HSS to local enthusiasts.
- Costa Mesa will feature their annual Lyons Fish Fry from Friday 31 May through Sunday 2 June. We
 had discussed the costs involved with participating in the event (\$500 for a booth, which is prohibitive)
 but emphasized our interest in participating. Robert felt that he can make special arrangements to
 eliminate the cost, and that we should submit a plan on what we wished to offer. This would likely be a
 static display in the area with the rest of the participants, and flying lessons and demonstrations at our
 runway. This plan is needed before 23 Jan 2013.
- John Anderson and Robert Knapp had lengthy discussions about the training classes that John offers.
 There may be some good opportunities for HSS to offer model aviation classes to the Costa Mesa community by linking to the STEM/STEAM programs.

A luncheon meeting was held to consolidate ideas and comments from the previous meetings.

- HSS has a need to attract and mentor youth and adults. A number of ideas were proposed, which
 included promoting RC cars on the mounds to the North East of the runway; RC boats if the city would
 permit use of the new ponds on the North side of the park; developing RC robotics as part of the club
 activities.
- New enthusiast training. Expand our Introductory Pilot program to increase our number of instructors, and include helicopters and First Person View (drone) instruction. AMA rules for qualifying as an instructor were distributed 27 Dec 2012. Contact Fred Hesse for copies.
- Fred H. will assemble the material for the quarterly Recreations Department catalog, and develop a plan for the June Fish Fry. These will be circulated to club officers for approval prior to submittal.












General Meeting Announcement For January 8th 2013

Note that to fly at Fairview Park you need the above permit, liability insurance (preferably AMA), and you need to follow City of Costa Mesa Ordinance No. 07-01, City Regulations for Issuance, Suspension and Revocation of Permits to Fly at Fairview Park, Academy of Model Aeronautics Safety Code, and the Fairview Park Flying Field Rules which are all posted at Fairview Park and on our web site at www.1hss.org. You do not need to be a Harbor Soaring Society member (but it is good to have you join us).

This is an original Basic Aircraft Technology winch built by Bob Harmon in Salt Lake City. These things are industrial works of art.


I'm the original owner and it was used as my "personal" unit when i wasn't flying with the club (Soaring League of North Texas).


