LAST SC2 OF 1983



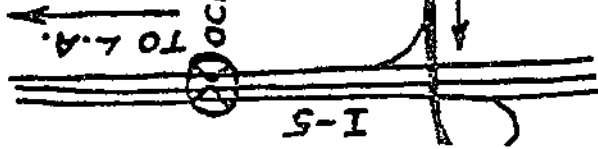

Open Launch order; sign up for frequency and fly any time after registration. 800 flight points and 200 landing points. Bell Curve.

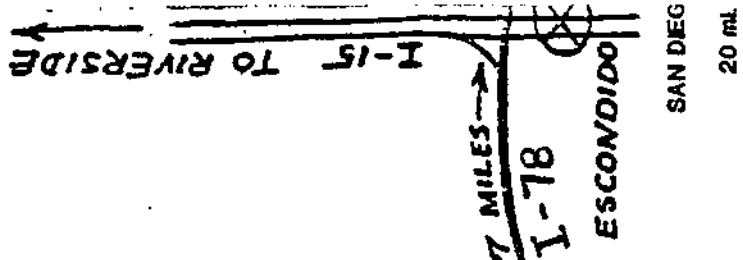
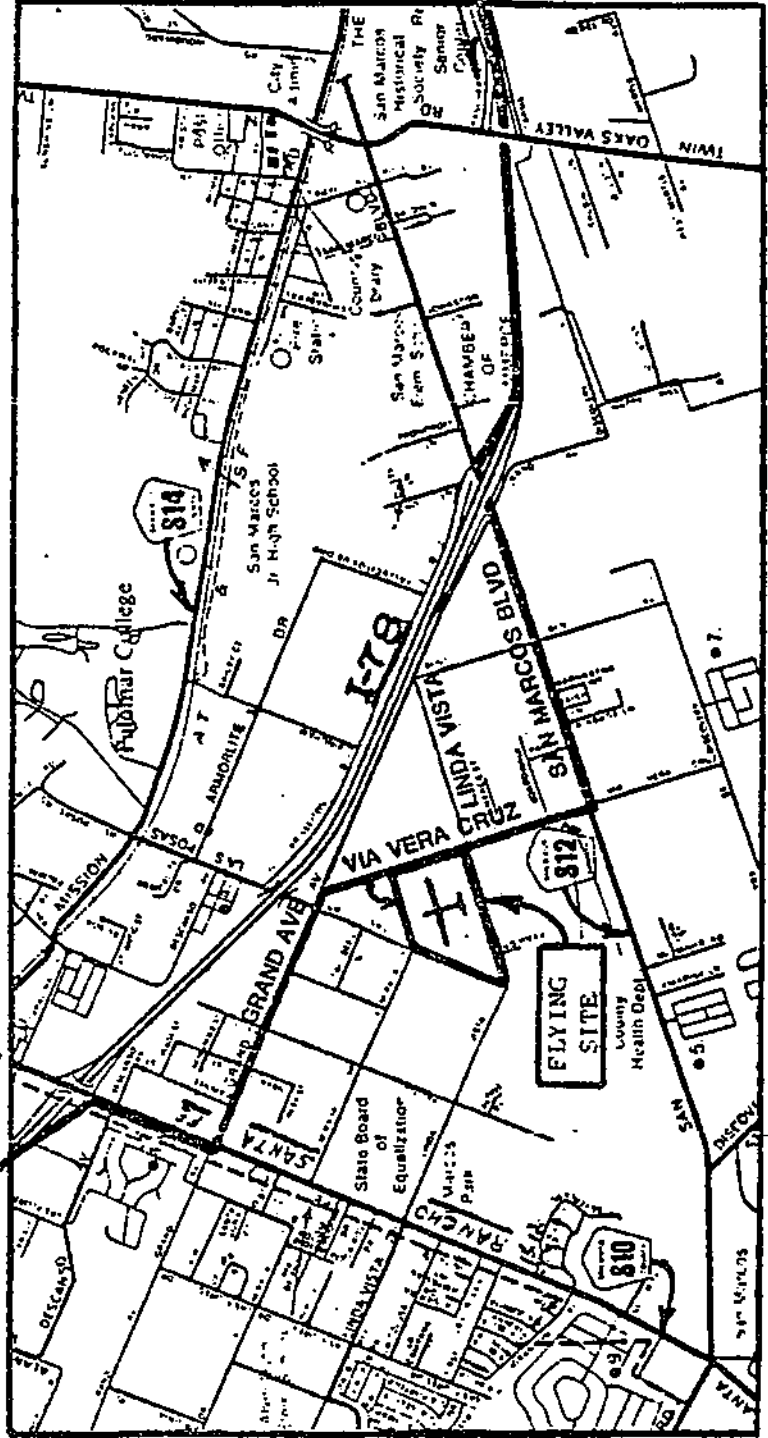
