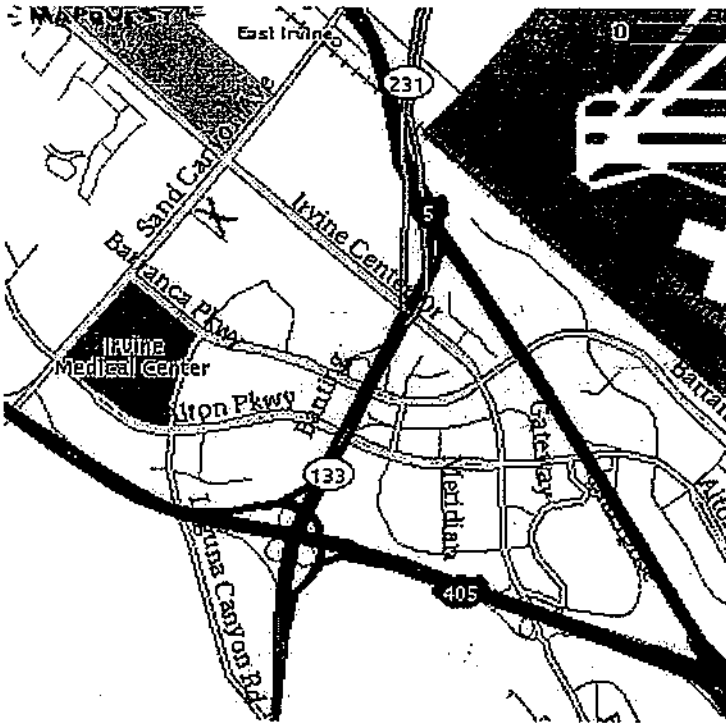

Robinson named a judge

Costa Mesa mayor, appointed by governor, is first black woman judge in Orange County

Gov. Gray Davis appointed Costa Mesa Mayor Karen Robinson to the Superior Court bench Wednesday, making her the first African-American woman to become a judge in the county.

"I don't think of it in those terms, but I am proud of my accomplishment, and if I am a role model -- and I hope I am one -- that's a bonus," she said.

Robinson, 39, will fill a vacancy created by the retirement of Judge Stuart Waldrip.

She lost a write-in campaign for a Superior Court seat last year, coming in third of eleven candidates seeking to replace former Superior Court Judge Ronald Kline, who faced state and federal charges of possession of child

pornography.

She was elected to the Costa Mesa City Council for a four-year term in 2000 and appointed mayor by her council colleagues in December. She works as lead attorney for the 23-campus California State University System.

By law, she must resign her City Council seat and her job at the university system before being sworn in as a judge. Robinson said she won't officially resign the posts until just before she is sworn in. A date for the swearing-in has not been set, although it is expected in about three weeks.

"I very much enjoy being on the council and working for the Cal State system, but it's been a lifelong dream of mine to be a judge," Robinson said.

For the past eight years, Robinson served as a judge pro tempore for the Municipal and Superior Courts, presiding over small-claims cases. She also has served as a

court-appointed arbitrator for the Superior Court.

In her post at the university system, Robinson handled matters of civil rights, employment and immigration disputes, public contracting and constitutional law issues.

She earned a bachelor's degree in political science and a law degree from UCLA.

There is at least one African-American man who is a judge in the county and several African-American women who are judges in the state, court spokeswoman Carole Levitzky said.

The appointment process for the judge seat was grueling, Robinson said. Hundreds of people and several law organizations were asked about her character and qualifications.

Robinson's salary as a judge will be \$139,476.
