FEBRUARY CLUB MEETING

The February meeting will be held on Wednesday, February 1, 1984 at 7:30PM at the Costa Mesa Consolidated Water District office, 1965 Placentia Avenue, Costa Mesa.

DUES ARE DUE

Dues are due by the end of our February meeting in order to qualify for the \$15 annual rate. Any senior member who pays after 2/1/84 will have to pay the same rate as new members, \$18.

FEBRUARY THERMAL CONTEST

The February contest will be held on Sunday, 2/5/84. Sign-ups will be at 8:30AM, pilots meeting at 8:45AM and the contest will begin at 9:00AM sharp.

1. This contest will be a 3 flight, add'em up to 16 minutes.
2. The first flight will be scored at 1 pt/sec with a maximum 100 pt. standard landing.
3. The second flight will be scored at 1 pt/sec with a maximum 100 pt. standard landing.
4. The third flight will be scored at 4 pt/sec for the first 3 minutes and 1 pt/sec for all time over 3 minutes with a maximum 100 pt. standard landing.

FEBRUARY THERMAL CONTEST (cont'd.)

5. There will be a maximum of 10 minutes for any single flight.
6. Each contestant is responsible for obtaining their own timer and must retrieve 3 lines.

MARCH & APRIL CONTESTS

The intent at this time is to hold our first Saturday contest in March and our first Electric contest in April. There will be more exacting details to follow.

H.S.S. THERMAL CONTEST FOR 1984

1. There will be 10 scheduled contests.
2. A minimum of 9 contests will be flown.
3. There will be 3 classes; open, advanced and sportsman.
4. There will be 2 awards for each class.
5. A lower class may win an award in a higher class.
6. Continuation of class advance shall be followed, that is; 3 wins in class or 2 awards in a higher class.
7. Year end awards shall be based upon best 8 of 10 contests. If only 9 contests are run, then best 7 of 9 shall be counted. Awards are available to club members only.
8. There shall be awards for top ten places at year end.
9. Contest fees will be \$2.00 for club members and \$4.00 for non members.
