April Contest

I am the CD for the April contest.
The first round gets off at 9:00 AM.
Tasks: Round 1- 2 min precision
700 pts flight
300 pts landing
Round 2- 10 min prec-dura
900 pts flight
100 pts landing
Round 3- 7 min triathlon
600 pts flight
300 pts precision
100 pts landing

Landing option "d" will be used,
called flight order for rounds 2
and 3. No sign ups after Round 1.

Club Contest Guidelines

1. Contests for the year 1980 will be scheduled for 12, with 2 throw aways for use in the final top 10 standings.
2. If a contest is cancelled there will be no make-up.
3. If 8 contests are attained for 1980 then one throw-away will be used for the top ten.
4. If 7 or less contests are attained then all contest scores will be used.
5. Contest dates are to be on the sunday following the first Wed. of each month.
6. Contests are scheduled to start at 9:00 am.
7. Proof of AMA membership and FCC license will be required.
8. All contests will be scheduled with at least 3 flights.
9. The third round shall not start after 2:00 pm.
10. AMA rules shall apply to situations not covered.
11. All thermal flights will require a landing within the "grass area" of the field for flight points to count.
12. Scores for the yearly top 10 will be based upon each score normalized to 1000.
13. Speed and distance type contests will not count towards the yearly top 10.
