

FLYING BEGINS AROUND 1:00pm.



Leisure Summer Festival 05 Electric Contest

August 14, 1982 Sponsor: Leisure Electronics

Rules:

Airplane — Your choice of design Powerplant — Stock Leisure or Astro Flight 05 motor Batteries — Six-cell pack

Three rounds of qualification flown man-on-man. Each round of qualification is 6-minute precision duration on a timed 1½-minute motor run followed by a spot landing. (900 flight points, 100 landing points). Top six flyers from qualification will fly an unlimited time flyoff from a 1½-minute motor run. No spot landing; last man down wins.

Trophies will be awarded for 1st through 6th place.

There will be an exhibition of electric sport planes and unlimited motor size planes between qualification rounds and flyoff.


