Holiday Awards Party

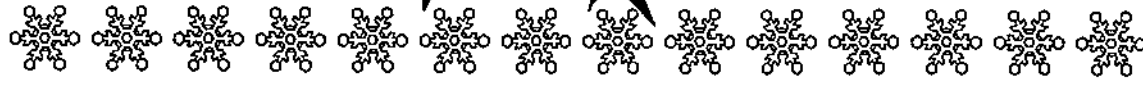

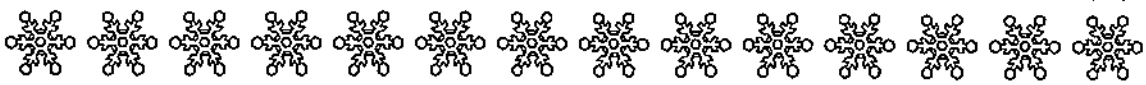

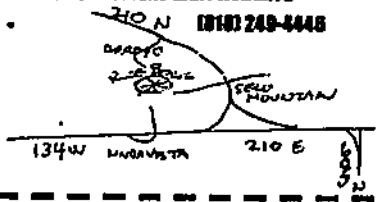
