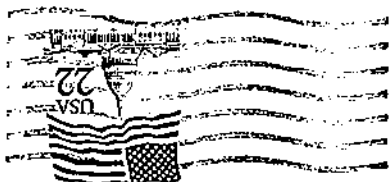

- Round 1: 2 minute precision. Scoring: 800 flight points, using the bell curve from the AMA rule book. 200 landing points using the 25 foot radius circle.
- Round 2: 10 minute man-on-man precision duration. Scoring: 900 flight points at 1.5 points per second. 100 landing points.
- Round 3: 5 minute precision duration. Scoring: 900 flight points at 3 points per second. 100 landing points.
