OCTOBER CLUB SAILPLANE CONTEST

October 11th 9:00 am

This contest will consist of three rounds of sailplane flying. Tentative tasks are as follows. The first round will be a two minute precision scored 500 flight points and 500 landing points. The flight points will be scored per the bell curve in the AMA rule book. The second and third rounds will be your choice of a five minute triathlon or a nine minute triathlon. Triathlon scoring is composed of three sources of points; flight, precision, and landing points. The flight points are scored as so many points per second, the precision points are scored on a +/- 30 second bell curve on every odd minute, and the landing points are on the usual 25 foot radius landing circle. The point breakdown for the five minute will be 600 flight, 200 precision, and 200 landing points, the landing area will be vee shaped. The nine minute point breakdown will probably be 800 flight, 100 precision, and 100 landing points.

## MINUTES of the September, 1987 Meeting

The meeting was brought to order at 7:40pm on August 2, at our usual meeting place in Costa Mesa. The minutes of the August, 1987 meeting (as presented in the August newsletter) were approved and voted into the record by the club members in attendance. After the treasurers report, new face Mark Puchalski (a power flyer friend of Dan Fink) was introduced to the club members.

Under old business: Mike Charles stood up and thanked the HSS club members for their great support during the recent F3B contest that was conducted at our field. The contest was apparently a great success with the finishers and helpers alike taking home some very nice prizes. At this time the club also voted to offer assistance in paying some of the outstanding debts from the contest (restroom charges for one). The idea was discussed to propose to hold the F3B team selection finals here at the Hss field. Also promoted was the idea to make an F3B contest, like the one held last month, an annual event to be hosted by the HSS.

Will Conrad announced that park construction at the flying field will likely start in May or June of 1988. Currently, plans are to reface the northwest facing section of the slope and to also re-level and grade-out the "lake" at the same time. We have been notified that we will be able to use the field on a continuous basis for the next 6 to 12 months before any significant construction may affect us.

HSS "calling/business" cards have been arranged for, and produced by, Jack Vail and Jack Duram. The cards are standard business card size and have basic HSS club information, along with a map telling how to get to our field.

New business: Herman Hall announced the tasks for the upcoming club contest that he will be CD'ing (see the newsletter). Worthy of mention is that this will be an AMA sanctioned contest and those that compete must have their AMA number on the wing.

Will Conrad mentioned that he had recently recieved a packet from AMA headquarters that contained embroidered patches for club officers.

Mike Charles announced an upcoming hand launch contest to be held later this year on December 5. Gordon Richke announced that those who were going to Visalia had better take their AMA ID cards (you will not be able to compete without proof of AMA membership).

Will Conrad announced that the Monokoting I and II tape, along with the fibreglassing techniques tape are available for club members to borrow. After discussion among the club membership in attendance, it was aged that the tape could be "checked out" for 10 days at a time by any club member without having to put down a deposit. This policy will remain in effect until further notice.

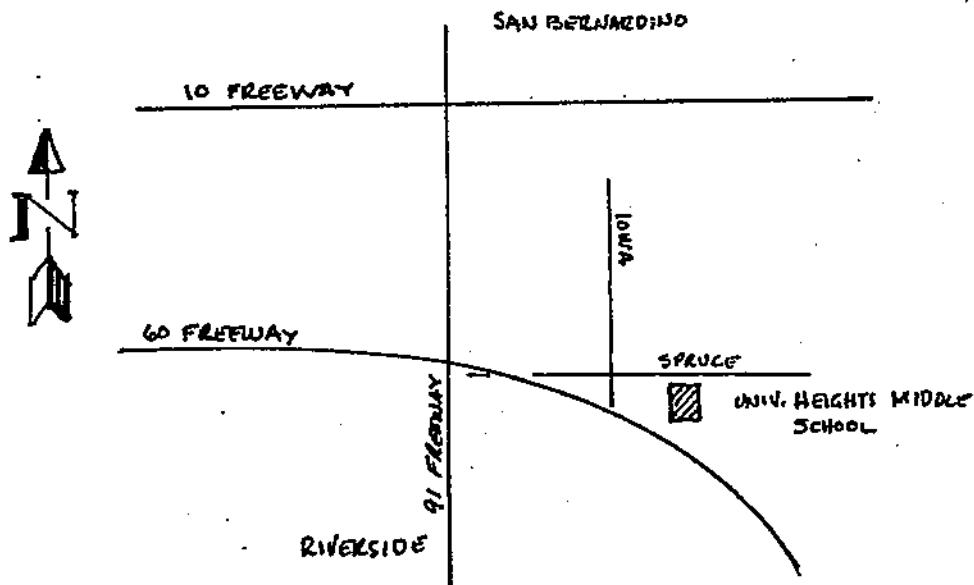

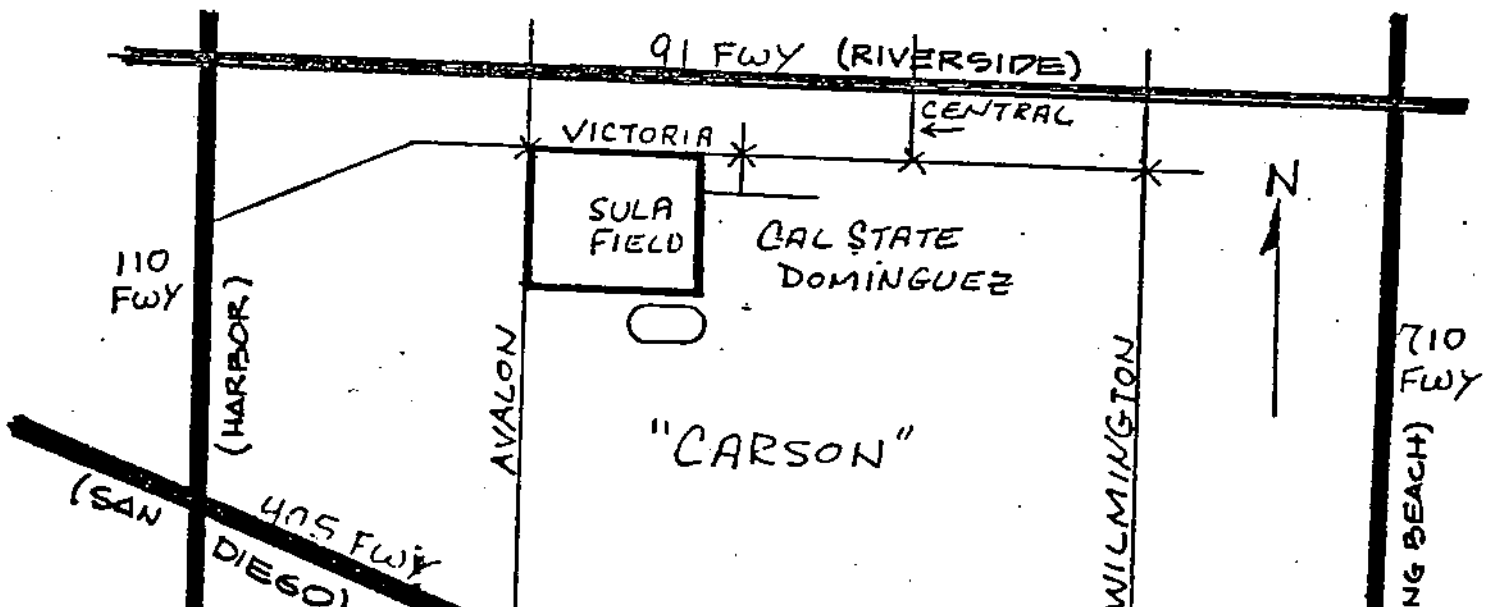
