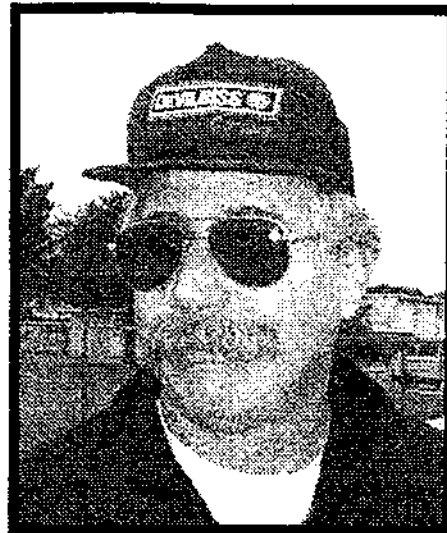
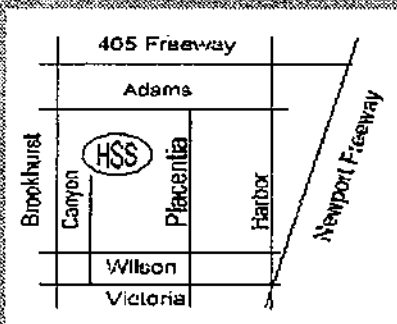

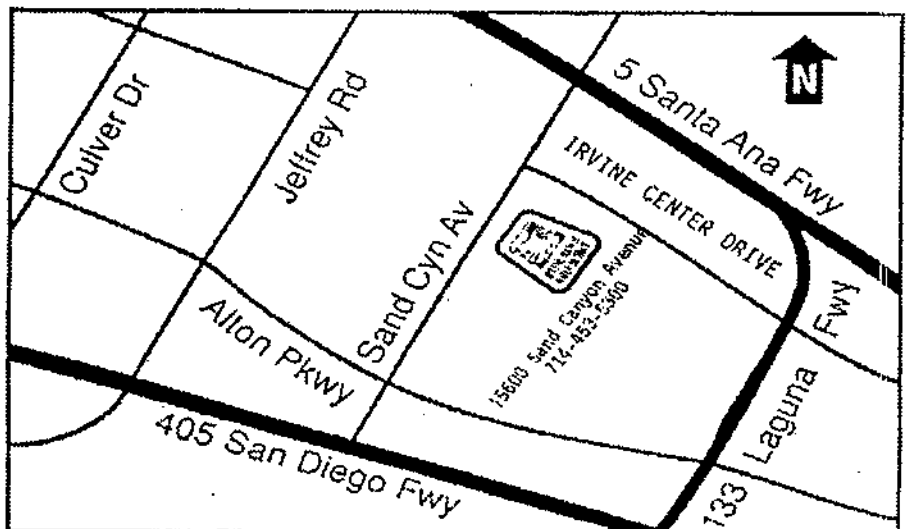
MESSAGE FROM THE OVAL ORIFICE

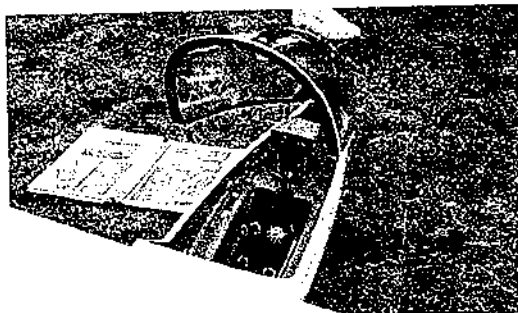

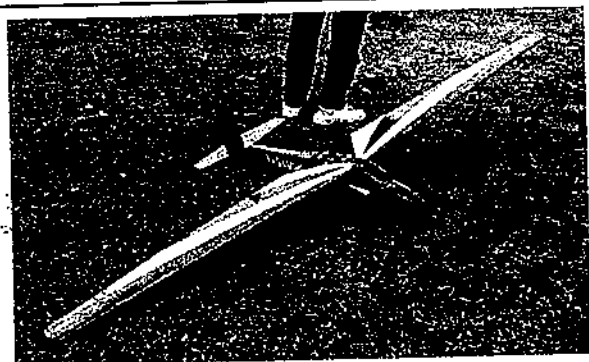

Cockpit detail of Dave Sanders' 1st place winning Cristal.



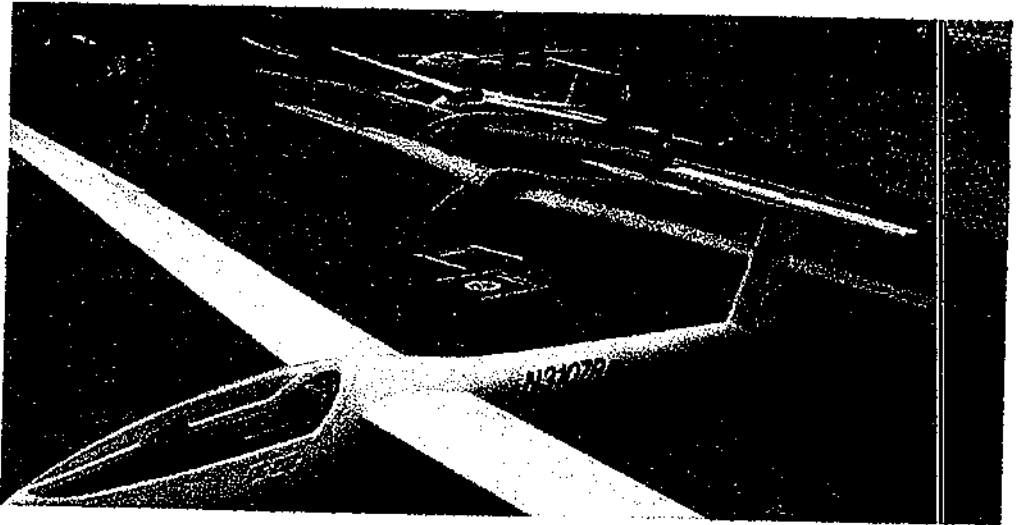
Mike Lance flew this prototype of the soon to be released DAW KA6e. Took third at Soar Utah.
