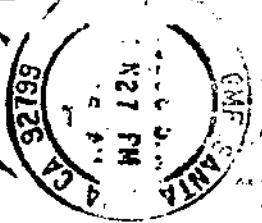
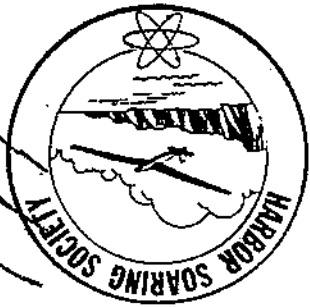

First Flight 9:00 A.M.

I. Old Timer - Duration Event

Open to all Old Timers. Run motors as many times as competitor needs to attain 20 minutes flight. Competitor must climb out a second time from below 100 feet before 15 minutes total flight time.

II. Orange County version of F3E

Rules for the event.

1. Order to fly and prep time will be established by C.D. at pilot's meeting.

2. There will be NO timing requirements during the distance task. Competitor may have his helper keep a count on total motor run so he will save some for the thermal task. Competitor is to fly as many laps as he chooses up to 20. Motor may be restarted behind Plane "a" only and must be stopped before entering the course.

3. Competitor must announce start of duration if duration is started before 20 laps are completed. Timer will keep glide time only. Precision of 5 minutes. Motor may be restarted for duration, Glide time must be stopped. Time is started when motor run is stopped. No motor runs after 4½ minutes of duration. Land in F3E landing circle.

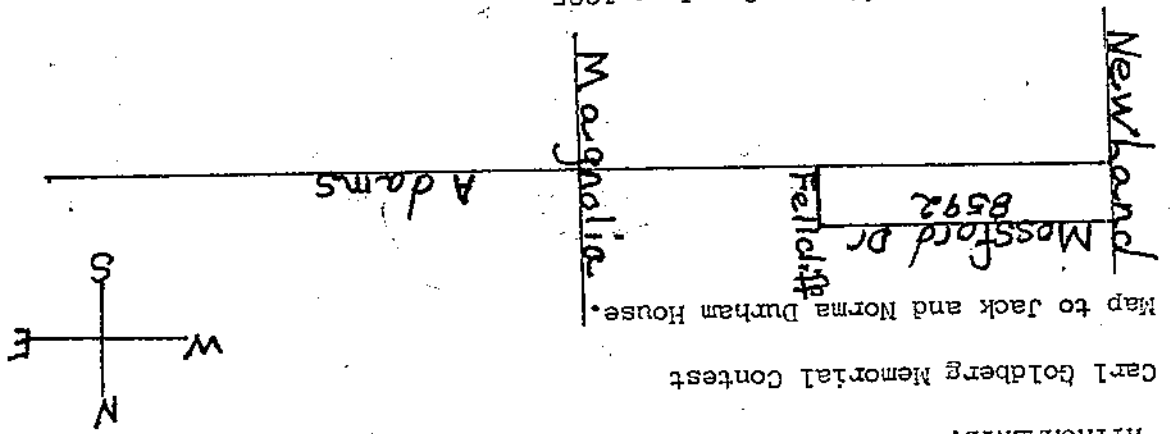
