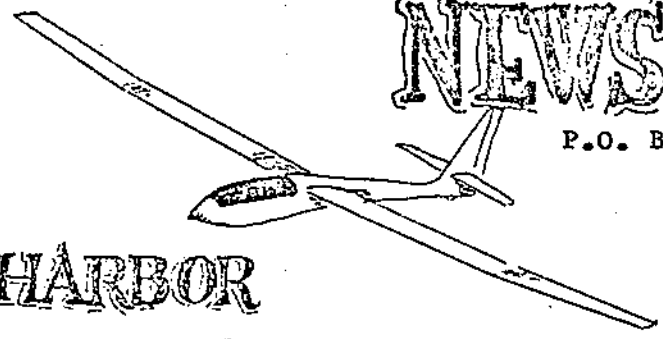

The contest consisted of 2 4-minute duration rounds and 5 10-minute duration rounds. First round each day was a 4-minute flight and Sat. 4 rounds were flown. 14 of the 68 contestants were H.S.S. members. Harbor did well in the final standings.
