First flight away at 9:00 AM ... *sharp!*

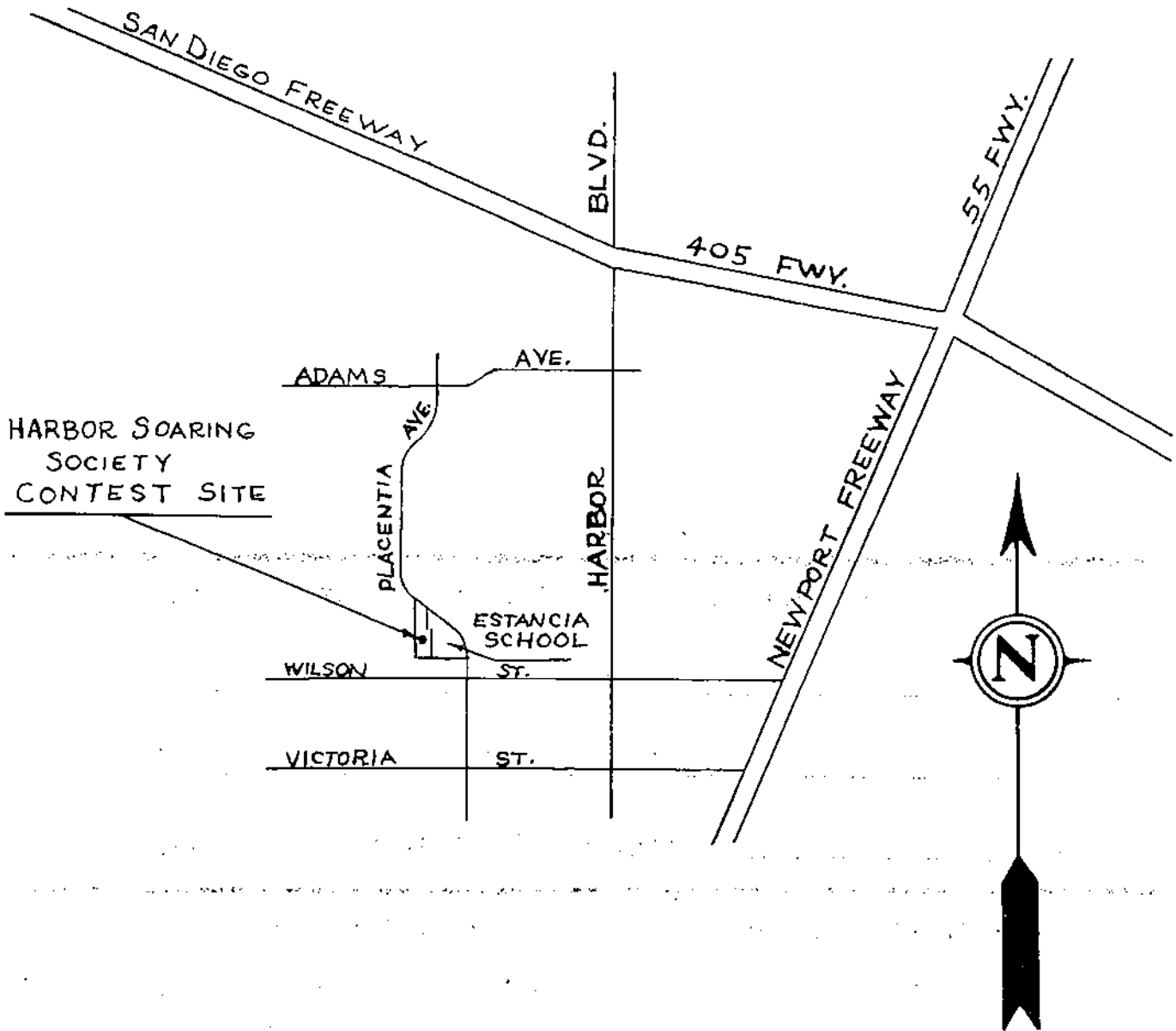
TASKS: 3 Rounds of 7 minute precision duration.
