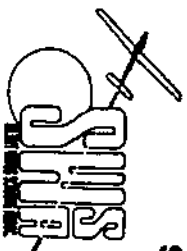

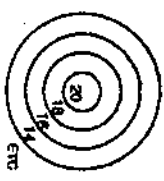

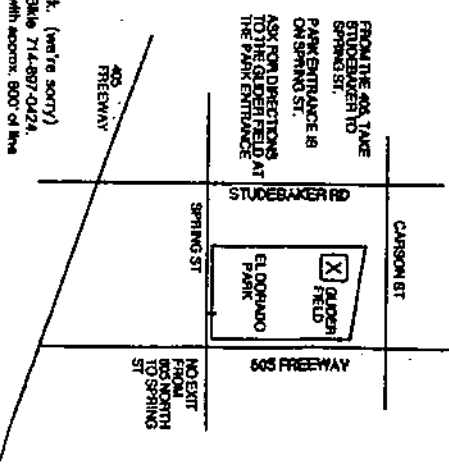

With clear blue skies and a warming trend in the area it looked like a great day of soaring for the 23 open class and 9 classic flyers to do battle in. Once the matrix was set and the pilots meeting completed flyers were called to the winches and launches began. Larry Jolly flying in the classic event had a first round pop-off which he turned into a beautiful max after working the low level stuff for several minutes/only 1 pop-off per contest allowed). Some unfortunate stuff also occurred with both Dick Pantzar and Al Cron losing planes on low. Matt(butternite)/Forger also had a stunt in mind, not to be out done by the classic disasters decided in his first round to show how to skin a Mako, no not with a knife as in fishing this was more in the way of a severe attempt on zooming which let the tight wing literally shed the top of the carbon surface in parts. Though the wing was de-laminated it managed to stay on the plane and Matt found himself the proud owner of a 1:06 minute flight and landing the plane safely!! 10 points. Of special note was that in the center of the circle was a 2 inch in diameter red dot that was going to reward the first person to nail it(if any) \$25.00!!
