Dean's Connectors

We were privileged to have Robin Dean give a presentation at our June meeting. He brought test equipment and knowledge about the connectors used in our electric models. Bottom line is, most of us use second-rate connectors just because that's what came in the plane from the factory. XTs and ECs are higher resistance and harder to solder to than Dean's. A simple test is to feel your connectors after a flight – if it's warm, it's inefficient.

Fire at Fairview

On Saturday June 23, there was a fire at Fairview Park, in the northwest corner somewhat near the pond. The CM Fire & Police depts responded quickly, along with fire crews from Huntington Beach, Newport Beach, and OC Fire, including a big CH-47 Chinook helicopter. The cause is still being investigated.







Lions Club 60th Fish Fry

The TRUST Test and FAA Registration

TRUST is <u>The Recreational UAS Safety Test</u>. It provides education and testing for recreational flyers on important safety and regulatory information. If you fly your drone recreationally under the <u>Exception for Recreational Flyers</u> you must pass the test before you fly. To take the test, go to http://trust.modelaircraft.org. This is the AMA Site. Take the test (Don't worry, it is fail proof) then obtain your "Completion Certificate."

All recreational flyers must pass this aeronautical knowledge and safety test and provide proof of test passage (the TRUST completion certificate) to the FAA or law enforcement upon request.

Go to http://faadronezone.faa.gov and create an account for your FAA Registration. Apply for "I fly under The Exception For Recreational Flyers". They will issue you an FAA registration number that must be affixed to the outside of all of your radio control model aircraft. The charge is \$3 for three years, for all of your R/C aircraft.

All recreational flyers must pass this aeronautical knowledge and safety test and provide proof of test passage (the TRUST completion certificate) to the FAA or law enforcement upon request.

Go to http://faadronezone.faa.gov and create an account for your FAA Registration. Apply for "I fly under The Exception For Recreational Flyers". They will issue you an FAA registration number that must be affixed to the outside of all of your radio control model aircraft. The charge is \$3 for three years, for all of your R/C aircraft.

If you renew your AMA membership online, be sure to print the receipt that they provide as proof that you joined. And, don't forget your City of Costa Mesa Flying Permit.
