September Club Contest CD - Chris Hurley

The September contest will be held on Sunday, September 10, 1988 at the Mack Freed Memorial Field flying site. The Contest will start at 9 AM.

The contest will consist of three rounds of flying using the 3-5-7 format. Scoring will be 700/300 for 3 minutes, 800/200 for 5 minutes and 900/100 for 7 minutes. Landings will be the standard 25 foot radius circles.

Meeting Minutes, August 1988

The meeting was brought to order by Treasurer Chris Hurley, 7:30 pm on August 3, 1988 at our usual meeting place in Costa Mesa. The meeting minutes for the July meeting were approved except for the typo in the price for Jim Frye's modification of the signs which should read \$50.00 not \$5.00. The minutes were voted into the record by the club members in attendance. The treasurers report was given by Chris Kurley and approved by the club.

Earl Wentworth was introduced to the club. Tony Martin is back from Australia and we are looking forward to seeing him at the field.

OLD BUSINESS:

- New name badges are in. They will be available at the next club meeting.
- Any new AMA members who have recently received their AMA * please contact a club officer so that we can enter it into our records.
- The board rejected the idea of holding a Lee Renaud Memorial Contest this year due to the number of contests already held. Due to intrest by the club it was decided to hold a contest at the end of February 1989, not to coincide with any other contest. Franck Chasteler volunteered to CD the contest and Ken Neyers will be the assistant CD.

NEW BUSINESS:

- A question was asked why Mack Freed Field was not used as the official name of the field on the SC² flyer. It will be added to future flyers but the field must also be described as located in Fairview Regional Park so that out of towners can find the field.
- Chris Hurley mentioned that the club might want to consider a dues increase to be discussed at the next meeting.
- Felix Vivas will reimburse HSS for expenses incured during the F3E trials.
- * Ken Meyers talked about a Old Time Blider contest. The sailplane design cutoff date for this class is 1947. Contests usually are 20 minute add em up. He will supply our newsletter editor with a copy of the rules to be published in the newsletter.
- ‡ Chris Hurley suggested that the club might want to consider ammending rule eight of the field rules. This rule limits frequency time to 15 minutes. The controversy centers around the fact that winch launched sailplanes get one launch attempt while hand launch gliders get many throws and take up the full alloted time. After much discussion it was decided to allow the board to come up with a solution.
- The meeting closed at 8:45 pm. Felix brought in some videos for entertainment.

Flying at the field has been pretty good for the past month, the prior two Saturdays to this writing, I have only been able to get in one flight on each occasion, because the were an hour long.

Last months contest had a very good showing, weather was great but there was a mishap that shouldn't have happened. Bill Brahams was flying his Cumic; appaently looked away for a moment then back. He thought he had his plane in sight, but it was another plane. He didn't realize it was the wrong plane until it hit the ground, straight down, and right in front of the scoring table in the pits. It is very important that you keep an eye or your timers eye on YOUR airplane at all times. Fortunately the only damage was to the aircraft. this could have been a major disaster, remember that safety should be our primary responsibility.
