HSS Meeting Minutes / July 1987

The meeting was brought to order at 7:37 PM at our usual meeting place in Costa Mesa. Opening comments included a reminder that our club bylaws were published in the June '87 HSS newsletter. It was also noted that there had been an incident recently, where the local constabulary complained about us flying our model airplanes too high at our field (this was also mentioned in the June newsletter). The flying too high comment drew considerable discussion from the audience. No formal action will be taken at this time.

The June '87 HSS club meeting minutes, as published in the June newsletter, were voted into the record by the club members who were in attendance. Will Conrad presented the treasurers report:

Old news: Frank Chesteler announced the results of the recent SC-Squared contest (HSS 3rd overall behind first place Clouds and second place PSA).

Apparently, during our last HSS contest, a couple non-members showed up, wanted to join the club, and to participate in the contest. There were no membership forms available at the time. The two were allowed to participate anyway (sort of an implied acceptance of membership). Both fliers ended up placing in the contest, but were denied a trophy because they were not "signed-up" members. This apparent injustice was discussed at length among the club body, and it was finally decided to award these fellows, a couple advanced-place trophies (after the fact). The main point to be made here is that there were no membership applications available on the morning of the contest when there should have been. It was agreed that from now on, we will keep a number of HSS sign-up forms (along with the AMA application forms) in the club contest box at all times.

An announcement was made noting that, since our membership "year" was now half over, any new member to HSS will pay a reduced rate of only \$10.00 to join our club.

Jack Vail gave a report on the progress of the Mall-Show Committee. Apparently mall shows are no longer "in" in southern California. Jack's overtures to South Coast Plaza and Fashion Valley were both turned down citing reasons that our idea would create too much foot traffic!?! (you would think that they would approve of something like that). Jack then promoted an alternative idea of setting up a booth at a swap meet. This idea was discussed briefly, then tabled for future consideration. Along a similar vein, business/calling cards are in the process of being printed up for distribution to club members. These cards will have basic club information and will include a map showing how to get to our field. These are meant to be a promotional item to be handed out to anyone who seems interested in our activities (they will also be made available at local hobby shops).
