# TAKE A SAILPLANE OUT TO LAUNCH

## Part II - DESERT COURSE

I've been sitting here for an hour trying to decide what to say. Many years ago I started out to develop a mathematical model of a sailplane launch. I found out that the problem was complex beyond my simple knowledge. In some 25 years of practical experience in sailplane launching, I find that the real world of launching is also complex. Good launching techniques require an infinite amount of experience and observation. I will offer a couple of related suggestions that may, or may not prove helpful.

Maximum towing strength does not result in maximum launch altitude. That is- pedal-to-the metal does not result in the tallest launch. This, of course, is not true in a down-wind launch. In this case you need all the forward speed you can muster to overcome the negative wind velocity.

During launch, the sailplane is really flying as though it were free of the winch line and flying straight and level. One difference is that the force of gravity is not acting perpendicular to the flight path, but down through the tail, acting like drag, subtracting from the lifting force of the airfoil. This is, of course, why light sailplanes launch better than lead sleds.

In launch attitude, the force of gravity is replaced with the towing force of the winch line applied to the tow hook. Two flying characteristics are still present - sink rate and L/D - the aircraft glide angle. In free flight, most times, one would like to minimize sink rate and maximize glide angle, or L/D. In free flight, sink rate is a function of wing loading - the lead sled sinks fastest, all other factors being equal. During launch, the sink rate is simply the rate the line is being taken onto the reel. Stand on the winch and the sink rate is at the maximum..

In free flight, as the angle of attack is increased, the L/D will increase, passing through a maximum just before the stall angle is reached. In order to sustain a given angle of attack, a given airspeed must be maintained. The winch, therefore must be pulsed at a rate to maintain this airspeed. On the other hand, too fast pulsing takes in line at a rate to increase sink rate. One can see that a delicate balance takes a bunch of practice, experience and observation of techniques used by those who have mastered the art of launching.

Speaking of towhook location. Center of gravity has only a minor effect on towhook location. The center of gravity is "The centroid of all forces of gravity acting on a body". During launch, the force of gravity acting on the center of gravity is right through the tail of the sailplane. When the sailplane is pulled through an arc by the action of the winch, it is likened to swinging a bucket of sand around ones head at the end of a rope.

There is an outward (centrifugal) force which acts on the CG of the bucket. If all the sand is at the bottom of the bucket, the bucket tends to tip down. If all the sand is at the top of the bucket, the bucket will tip up. The same with a sailplane. If the towhook is forward of the CG, the nose will be forced down., if it is aft of the CG, the ship will nose up. However, it takes a considerable displacement of CG from the tow line vector to cause big results.

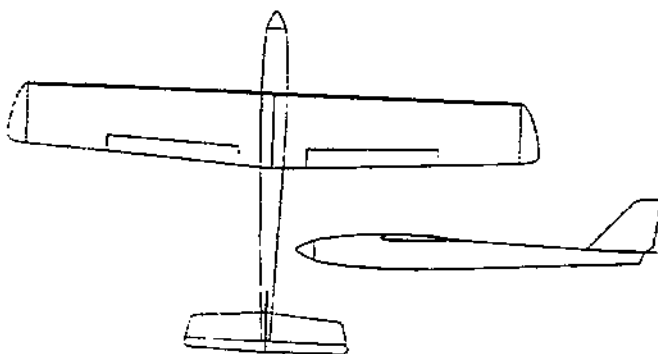
The real culprit in towhook placement is its relation to the center of lift of the wing. I reckon the ideal towhook placement is that which directs the tow force vector (the extension of the towline through the fuselage) through the center of lift of the wing. One problem is that nothing stays still. The tow force vector changes with launch angle. The center of lift changes as a function of airfoil type and angle of attack. In most airfoils, the center of lift moves foreward as angle of attack increases. With an aft towhook location, the towing force vector passes aft of the center of lift. This causes the nose to pitch up. With increased angle of attack, the center of lift moves forward. The action is regenerative and the nose pitches up more. If corrective action is not taken, the sailplane will pop off the line. With too forward towhook locations, the opposite will occur. The nose is forced down decreasing the angle of attack which moves the center of lift aft causing more down force on the nose. It can even be difficult to raise the nose of the sailplane, if too little elevator authority is present. Proper towhook location is a matter of trial and error for each airfoil and sailplane configuration. One confusion is that, to a degree, the results between too far forward and too far aft can appear similar. Too far forward can result in a "flapping flag" instability. Too far aft results in "neutral point" instability which also can cause a weaving launch. In taking corrective action you will find an abundance of experts willing to offer suggestions.
