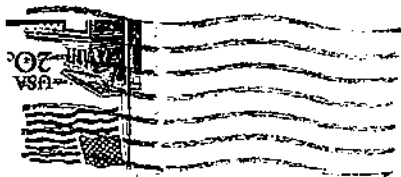
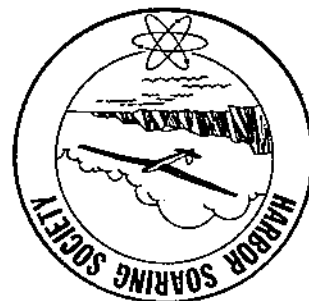

Dear Craig:

I have enclosed information on the HSS SC<sup>2</sup> Contest to be held on Nov. 20, 1983. The contest notice will be published in our Oct. newsletter. The contest will be as follows:

Event: 3 rounds of thermal soaring with emphasis on landing.

Location: Fairview Park, Costa Mesa, California.

Tasks: 1st round - 3 minute precision, flight value 900 points, landing 100 points. 5 points per second off for each second over or under 3 minutes.

2nd round - 5 minute precision, flight value 900 points, landing 100 points. 5 points per second off for each second over or under 3 minutes.

3rd round - 1 minute precision, flight value 500 points, landing 500 points. 5 points per second off for each second over or under 1 minute.

If any parts break or come off aircraft or aircraft is damaged beyond safe flight, the landing points will be 0; this includes the 3rd round.

Standard landing spots of 25 feet with tapes.

All rounds will be called flight order.

Winches: 6 and 12 volt winches and line retrieval provided. Approximately 400 foot lines.

Landing area: Hard, dry dirt with some dry brown grass.

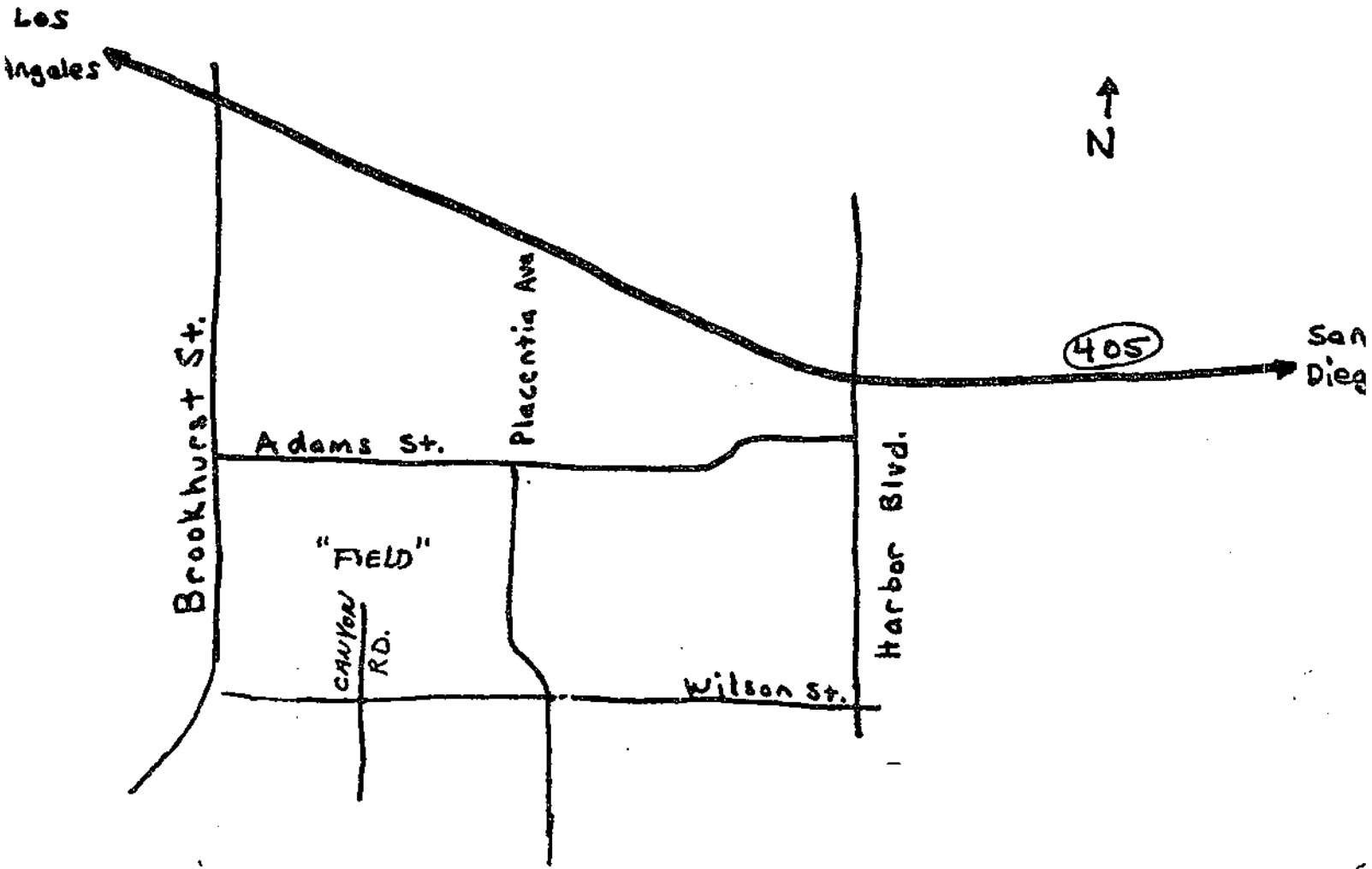
Awards: 1st through 10th places, Open Class, trophies and plaques and 4 plaques for top 4 places for the top placing club team.

Registration: Sign up opens at 8:00 A. M. and ends at 9:00 A. M. Pilots' meeting at 9:00 A. M. Flying will start at 9:15 A. M. Proof of AMA membership required. \$5.50 entry fee.
