PICNIC FOR JULY

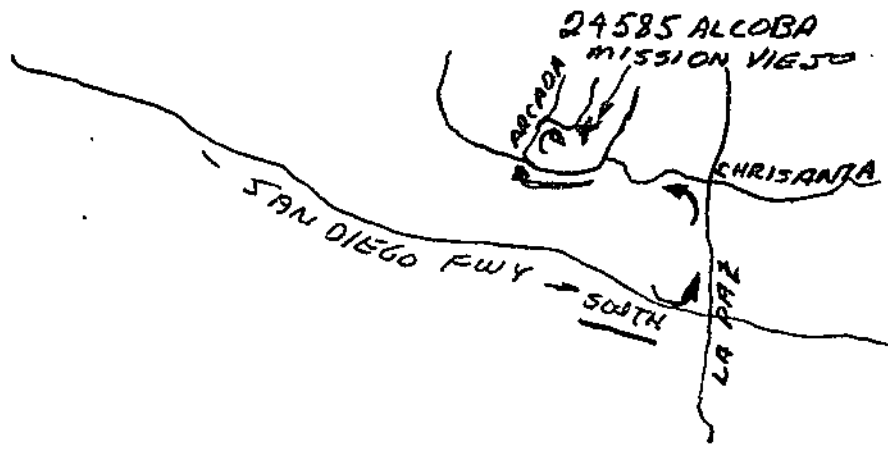
